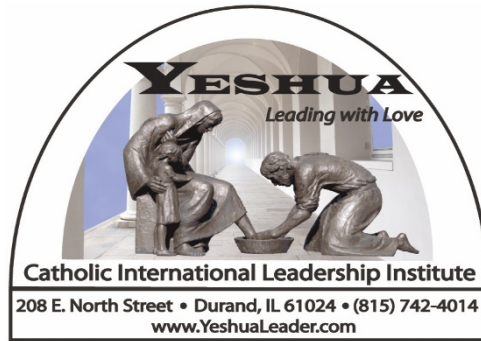

Breakout Discussion Questions

[Please print and have available for your class sessions on Zoom]

REMINDER: Breakout groups are assigned randomly at the start of each breakout session. So you will be in a group with at least some different people each time you join a breakout session. At the start of each session:

- Introduce yourselves very briefly. (Name, parish and city)
- If you have been given criteria for picking a leader, use it to identify your leader.
- Begin discussion.

Breakout #1 – Today video

1. Take turns mentioning a scene that particularly stood out for you.
2. Did you notice a progression from one encounter to the next?
3. Discuss the primary lesson or lessons you learned from this video.
4. Briefly share the names of 3 people who have been a positive influence in your life and explain how they helped contribute to your development.

Breakout #2 – Our Christian endowment

1. Read the passage from St. Paul's first letter to Christians in Corinth (found on pp. 18-19 in your workbook).
2. While you read, underline or highlight words and phrases that stand out for you.
3. When members of your group are done reading, please go around and share one thing you have marked.
4. Continue until you have exhausted marked items or you are called back to the general session.

Breakout #3 – What is Sanctification?

Use these questions as the basis for a discussion on notion of "sanctification"

1. Were you familiar with the term before today?
2. What do you think of the quotation of Pope Paul VI on p. 29?
3. Are you comfortable with what he advises? Why or why not?
4. How might you, in your particular circumstances "sanctify the world"?
5. How might you help others "sanctify the world"?

Breakout #4 – The Leadership of Jesus

1. In your own words, what did Jesus say about leadership – what did he want us to do and what did he want us not to do?
2. Do you think his instructions and example are practical and relevant in our lives?
3. Why or why not?
4. What personal characteristics would a person have to cultivate to be an effective leader like Jesus?
