





LECTIO

Read the text slowly and prayerfully, Constantly listening for that word that God has prepared for you. Listen and receive the Word that God speaks to you.

ORATIO

Prayer is your response to God's word. Enter into this loving conversation with God,

MEDITATIO


When a word or phrase strikes you, stop and rest with it. Allow it to speak to you in a personal way by pondering the word in your heart, reflecting on what it means to you.

CONTEMPLATIO

Rest in God's presence and receive His transforming embrace. Remember that contemplation is not your action or doing, rather it is allowing God to act in you. **SECTION TWO**

We have rediscovered the fundamental role of the first announcement or kerygma, which needs to be the centre of all evangelizing activity and all efforts at Church renewal...

This first proclamation is called "first" not because it exists at the beginning and can then be forgotten or replaced by other more important things. It is first in a qualitative sense because it is the principal proclamation, the one which we must hear again and again in different ways, the one which we must announce one way or another throughout the process of catechesis, at every level and moment.
